



2008 Maricopa County 4-H Belt Buckle Bonanza Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors must be a Maricopa county resident and Maricopa County 4-H member in good standing.
2. All returning 4-H members must have turned in a 4-H record book and or portfolio for the prior year on time, regardless of the points scored.
3. All entries are to be postmarked by March 1, 2008 and mailed to John Hunt 20100 W. Dunlap Buckeye, Az 85326 or delivered to Amy Nuggent at the Extension Office by March 1st.
4. Checks or Money orders are to be made out to Maricopa County 4-H Large Livestock Committee.
5. All required paperwork for that species is to be in the hands of the exhibitor upon arrival.
6. All entries are final and there will be no refunds.
7. Dress Code for the show is the same as Maricopa County Fair. Clean dark blue or black jeans, belted; solid green or solid white collared and sleeved shirt and tie or scarf. Club vests are permitted. Shirts are to be tucked in. Official 4-H emblem logo/patch is required. Patch/logo should be visible at all times (on vest or shirt). Closed toe shoes only.
8. Exhibitors must sign and follow the National Show Ring Code of Ethics.
9. Pens are provided, although no bedding in pens is allowed.
10. Due to limited space, swine exhibitors are only allowed to bring one pig to the show. A substitution may be allowed due to unforeseen circumstances.
11. Exhibitors must care and fit their own animals.
12. Minimal electricity will be available, so please plan accordingly. Please bring animals ready to show.
13. Market Classes will be determined upon weigh-in of all animals.
14. Any animal can and will be turned away at the discretion of the Species Superintendent.
15. All animals must be owned and in the care of the exhibitor prior to January 12, 2008.
16. All animals must be shown under the rules appropriate for that breed.
17. Safety is of the utmost importance and will be enforced by species superintendents and committee.
18. All Judges' decisions are final.
19. There will no parking within 25ft of the show arena.
20. All exceptions, interpretations, or grievances will be taken up with the species superintendent, Maricopa County Large Livestock Committee, with approval by the Maricopa County 4-H Agent for the Large Livestock.
